Flower Power Mixed Media

Remember don't let the material list overwhelm you. These are all suggestions get close. E-mail or call if you are concerned.

Brushes: sizes of brushes are suggestions. Check Silver Brush Ltd.

- 1 inch square
- #3 rigor, script, or liner brush (long and thin)
- #8 or 10 round brush
- #2 bright bristle brush
- Palette knife (important)

Pigments: QoR /Grumbacher/Winsor Newton/American Journey student grade is a good start.

- Primary colors: red, yellow, blue, and sepia – I will have some colors to share.
- A set is fine. Bring colors you love, think floral colors!

Note: Colors don't have to be exact. Make sure to pick a blue and red that creates a good purple.

Paper:

- 140lb. acid-free rough watercolor paper (available to purchase at class). Paper can be purchased by the sheet so you can experiment.

Palette:

- Styrofoam plate is a good start. Disposable paper palette or aluminum foil also work.

Extra Items:

- 2 water containers
- Toothbrush
- Toilet paper
- Paint rag
- Pencil
- Small piece of sponge
- Blow-dryer
- Molding paste
- Gel medium gloss/matte or satin (very important)
