Materials you must bring:

- A small piece of wood furniture (wood only, no laminate/Ikea type furniture) such as a nightstand or side table. Can be something you have and want to update, something you buy at a thrift store, receive from a family member or friend, garage sale, marketplace etc. No chairs. Message me if you have any questions about your piece.
- A sample size flat interior paint from Home Depot or Lowes color of your choice. Please stick with darker colors (green, blue, red, black, grey etc.) as opposed to light colors like white, tan. If you do want to use a lighter color, please message me beforehand. If you cannot get flat, eggshell or satin are ok, just do not get semi gloss or gloss.
- The clothing you wear should be comfortable and ok to get dirty.
- Comfortable shoes (I always wear flip flops)
- Optional items:
 - Sunscreen
 - Hat
 - Hand sanding block/"mouse" for hook and loop sandpaper can be found on Amazon
 - Clear protective eye wear can be found at the dollar store, Home Depot, or Lowes
 - Gardener's kneeling pad can be found at the dollar store
 - Lunch, snacks, and water
