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## Let's Paint an Iris

Remember don't let the material list overwhelm you. These are all suggestions get close. E-mail or call if you are concerned.

Brushes: sizes of brushes are suggestions

- #2 bristle brush
- 1-inch square or flat aquarelle (beveled edge used in place of a palette knife)
- 2-inch inexpensive pastry brush, or 2-inch flat brush or hake (to apply washes) optional
- #4 rigor, script, or liner brush (long and thin)
- #10 round brush (optional)
- Round and inexpensive miskit/maskoid fluid brush
- Palette knife (credit card, nail clipper, emery board, pocketknife will work)

**<u>Pigments:</u>** QoR/Grumbacher/Winsor Newton/American Journey student grade is a good start.

• Primary colors: red, yellow, blue, and sepia will work for this class.

## Papers:

• 140lb.. acid-free rough watercolor paper available to purchase at class

## Palette:

• White with sections for painting and mixing (non-absorbent). A melmac or Styrofoam plate is a good start.
