- #2 bristle brush
- 1 inch square or flat aquarelle
- 2 inch pastry brush, flat brush, or hake (optional)
- #4 rigor, script, or liner brush (long and thin)
- #8 round brush
- Miskit/maskoid fluid brush (round and inexpensive)
- Palette knife (credit card, nail clipper, emery board, pocketknife will work)

Pigments: QOR Golden/Grumbacher/Winsor Newton

• **Primary colors:** Red, Yellow, Blue and Sepia will work for this class. <u>Think sunflowers if you want to add additional colors.</u>

Papers:

• 140lb. Archer's acid-free rough watercolor paper (available to purchase at class). Paper can be purchased by sheet so you can experiment.

Palette:

• White with sections for painting and mixing (non-absorbent). A Melmac or Styrofoam plate is a good start.
